What to bring to Nursery

Change of Clothing

The nursery will supply each child with a slipper bag. It will hang on their coat peg and a complete change of clothes can be placed in it.

Accidents do happen which may embarrass the child, or indeed they may get paint on themselves and they may prefer to be changed into their change of clothes. Please help us by dressing your child so that he/she is able to manage themselves at the toilet. We are always here to help, but one of our aims is to develop his/her independence. We will put wet clothes in a plastic bag for you to take home. Don't forget to replenish the bag from time to time as the clothes get used.

Of course we all like our children to be clean and tidy, but please remember that we want the children to experience all activities, some of which can be quite messy! <u>We</u> don't do the gardening in our good clothes. The children are here to enjoy themselves!

During the winter months, a hat, scarf and gloves are necessary for cold and windy days. Open sandals, laced shoes and buckles can be very dangerous when children are involved in physical activity. Children should wear Velcro fastening trainers to Nursery. Outdoor play can be very cold in our Nursery, so it is vital to have a coat to wear - even during spring months etc.

The Nursery uniform

- Navy tracksuit bottoms/navy leggings
- White polo shirt
- Nursery sweatshirt
- Velcro trainers

In the summer months shorts may be worn to Nursery. Velcro trainers should be worn throughout the year due to the physical nature of the busy Nursery day (no sandals, dresses or skirts please.) Please put your child's name on his/ her coat and sweatshirts as they all look the same. Details are available of the uniform suppliers.
